

ACCESSING SUBSTANCE ABUSE TREATMENT

There are two different processes through which an individual would seek substance use disorder treatment, depending on whether or not they have health insurance.

HEALTH INSURANCE

If an individual has health insurance, they would need to contact their insurance provider to obtain information on their substance use disorder treatment benefits. This is usually done by calling the "Customer Service" number on the back of the card. In some cases, there is a specific number for Behavioral Health or Substance Abuse services. The individual would want to ask about what specific services are covered and what their deductible and copay are. In addition, they would need to ask for a referral to in-network providers and if they can call the provider on their own or if they need to get prior approval from the insurance company.

Publicly FUNDED ASSISTANCE

If an individual has Medicaid or does not have health insurance and meets certain income guidelines, they may qualify for services through the county in which they reside. The individual would need to contact the Access Center for substance use disorder treatment in their county.

Upon contacting the appropriate Access Center, the individual would complete a screening over the phone to determine eligibility and what type of substance use disorder services would best meet their needs. From there, a referral to services will be made. If the client does not qualify for services through the county, they will be provided with numbers to treatment agencies where they could self-pay for services.
